Product	NUTSHELL Tuf Wood Oil is an open porous, transparent primer for interior use. The application can be repeated one or more times to reach a satisfactory finish or NUTSHELL Tuf Wood Wax can be applied for a finishing effect.
Ingredients	Balsam turpin oil, orange peel oil, linseed stand oil, wood oil and castor oil, concentrated colophony -stand oil, cobalt manganese, zirconium, and lead free zinc dryer.
Coverage	Coverage approximately 10 sq. metre per litre. Actual consumption depends on the quality of the surface and the method by which it is applied.
Areas of use	Interior wood or cork floors, stairs and window sills.
Size	Available in 0.75 litre and 2.5 litre tins. Density: approx 0.9 g/cm ³
Preparation	The surface should be clean, dust free, open porous and thoroughly dried. Remove any contamination with a cloth. Exotic woods should be cleaned with an alcohol cleaner before applying. Old lacquer coatings have to be removed. Sand old paint before application.
Application	<p>Application Methods: Paint, polish, roller, spray</p> <p>Apply first coat thinly, thoroughly and evenly along the grain of the wood. Remove surplus and leave to dry overnight (at least 8-10 hours) ensuring good ventilation.</p> <p>Apply second coat as above.</p> <p>Do not apply on large areas all at once, because you cannot spread the oil evenly once it has become sticky.</p> <p><u>Polish</u>: By applying the oil on floors preferably using a single-disc machine with polishing pad and apply as above.</p> <p><u>Roller</u>: Apply oil thinly and without bubbles.</p> <p><u>Spray</u>: Apply in thin layers. Continue as described above. On cork further treatment may be necessary after drying.</p>
Drying Time	<p>Do not apply under 14°C</p> <p>From 12 - 24 hours depending on weather and temperature. Final hardness is achieved after 2 - 4 weeks. On cork, drying times over 48 hours may be necessary.</p>
Thinning & Cleaning	Use Nutshell Citrus Peel Oil.

Storage & Handling

Store in a cool, but definitely frost free place, in a well closed container. Always keep container closed and out of reach of children. NUTSHELL products are biodegradable, but PLEASE do not pour the remainder down the drain.

Safety

Saturated cleaning rags should be stored in a closed container to prevent the possibility of spontaneous combustion. Or soak the rag in water and let it dry. On Contact with the skin or eyes, clean quickly with soap and plenty of water. Do not smoke or use an open light whilst working and air rooms thoroughly. Wear respiratory protection when spraying the product. Also keep ecological paints away from children. Product is classified as irritant (XI) because of the content of natural essential oils.
